Reminders

NO BUS PASSES WILL BE ISSUED ON FRIDAYS!!

IMPORTANT: All students' **must report to the main office to sign in** when coming to school late and all students **must report to the main office to sign out** when being picked up early from school for appointments.

***STUDENTS:** Please be aware that you are not allowed in the building (using the auditorium entrance) prior to **7:15**. In the unfortunate case that you must be dropped off earlier than 7:15, you should be dropped off at the main entrance and must wait in the main lobby until the doors open at 7:30.
